Description of Category

The winners of this category, to be judged by a specialist panel, should reflect the all-round spirit of the late Brian White as a journalist and broadcaster. Importantly, it recognises sustained journalistic achievement and effort and covers all aspects of radio journalism.

This is not a news reading, straight interviewing or commentary award. It is an opportunity to demonstrate a blend of key journalistic skills making listeners feel as if they are on the spot, involved at a key event, or are getting new and exclusive information, perspective or listening to the "breaking" of an important story.

The judges will be looking for demonstration of a variety of journalistic skills, not only news reading. Entries should demonstrate absolute professionalism and an 'above and beyond' effort in covering major events or particularly interesting news stories throughout the judging period.

They will consider the variety, treatment, accuracy, relevance, presentation, scripting, scope and depth of information and the use of resources.

NB: This category can only be entered by an individual – teams are not eligible.
